The Byford Progress Association Inc extends an invitation to you to exhibit a maximum of two artworks in their **Byford Fine Arts 2011 "New Horizons"** Art exhibition to be held in 2011 from 6.30 to 9pm on September 9 and from 9.30am to 5pm on September 10 and 11.

The exhibition will once again be held at the **SJ Recreation Centre, Mead Street, Byford**, and several improvements have been made to the Kingia Room including picture rails on the walls to facilitate the hanging of larger paintings.

The main prize has been increased to **\$10,000**, with four additional "Highly Commended" prizes of **\$500.00** each to be awarded on behalf of our sponsors for the categories of Painting (mixed media), Landscape, Sculpture/3D and Local Artist. The main prize and category awards will be selected by a panel of three Judges.

A People's Choice Certificate will also be awarded.

The Exhibition is an **Invitational** event showcasing a maximum of 150 pieces from 75 artists with the aim of providing the public with a varied and diverse range of Artworks.

Our intention is to increase the quality of artworks entered whilst at the same time encouraging some very talented, emerging artists. We have received interest from NSW and as far afield as New Zealand and Italy.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries:

1. The Byford Fine Art Exhibition is an invitational award.
2. Each artist is to supply a maximum of two pieces of completed works. Artists may also supply a CV and two images of artwork to byfordfinearts@gmail.com.
3. All entries will be entered into the Major \$10,000 Prize and be eligible for Category awards.
4. Local Artist category is open to artists who are permanent residents of the Serpentine-Jarrahdale Shire.

Artwork and submissions:

5. A handling fee of **\$30.00 per entry** is required with the signed entry form which must be received before 5pm on **30th July 2011**. Payment may be by Electronic Fund transfer A/C Name Byford Progress Ass **BSB 633 108 A/C 125977314** (please reference with your full name), Money Order or cheque (made payable to the Byford Progress Association). A refund will only be given if artwork is deemed unsuitable for exhibition or display by the event organisers.
6. Entries are limited to two **original** works (2) per artist. The entry must be the original work of the entrant. The size of the work must not exceed 3 metres in height or weigh more than 100kgs. Multiple panels will be accepted where these constitute a single artwork and do not exceed the specified limits in height or weight. The completed entry label provided must be attached to the back of the artwork.
7. Entries must be suitably presented for display and handling (i.e. dry, properly affixed wire/cord to hold weight of work) and framed to a professional standard. A stretched canvas is considered framed.
8. Works not selected for hanging must be collected Saturday 10th September between 10am – 12noon.
9. If the Entrant has an ABN number and is registered for the GST, GST must be included in the sale price.
10. The sale price of the artwork must include a commission of 25%.
11. The Committee reserves the right to pre-select artworks for exhibition.
12. The Entrant must complete the declaration on the entry form.
13. Entrants are to allow the image of their artwork to be used for publicity and promotional purposes of the exhibition and to be photographed by the event organisers.

Delivery/Collection of Artworks:

14. Delivery and collection of works, as well as transport/freight costs, are the responsibility of the artist. No payment will be made by the organisers of Byford Fine Art Exhibition, nor responsibility taken, for freight or other charges incurred in the delivery of the Artworks to or from the venue.
15. **It is the responsibility of the artist to maintain his/her insurance for their works.** Entrants will not hold the organizers, its officials, volunteers, employees, agents and servants responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever, and however caused, to any work while in its custody.
16. Artwork is to be delivered on **Friday 9th September 2011** between 9.00am— 11.00am to **SJ Recreation Centre, Mead St, BYFORD 6122**
17. Artists (or agent with signed authority) must arrange collection of works on **11th September** between 4:00pm—6:00pm.
18. Receipt/Identification will be required upon collection. Any works not collected at this time will incur a \$50 per day handling/storage fee.

Judging:

19. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
20. The winners will be announced at the Awards presentation at 7.30pm on Friday 9th September 2011. The People's Choice Award will be announced at the end of the Exhibition (4.00pm Sunday 11th September 2011).
